Facts about:

- 26.513 thousand km2
- 4.39% of the territory of Ukraine
- Rural region with the lowest urbanisation rate (40%)
- In hromadas there are less then 50K imhabitants
- The biggest amount of settlements in Ukraine
- 6 districts and 63 territorial communities/hromadas
- 1,55 mln of inhabitants (incl.140+ IDPs the highest rate in Ukraine), Vinnytsia city
 - 357K inhabitants
- Vinnytsia received the European Energy Award and recently joined the European Green Course
- Capital of a modern balneological resort/radon water


Vinnytsia region and the WAR



On July 14, 2022, Russian troops attacked Vinnytsia with cruise missiles, taking 29 lives, including 4 children, and injuring 219 people. As a result, 128 residential buildings, a maternity hospital, 2 hospitals, a lyceum, 3 kindergartens, 2 cultural institutions, a temple, architectural and historical monuments of local and national significance were damaged.

DAMAGES OF THE CRTICIAL INFRUSTRUCTURE, BLACKOUTS.

The Decentralisation reform in Ukraine promoting Community-Led Local Development" (CLLD)



- Granting the communities new sources of income, mainly provided through the redistribution of tax income between the State Budget and local budgets and by launching new subventions for the improvement of infrastructure and public services.
- **Development of democratic tools at local level** (participatory budgets, public hearings, etc.);
- Activation of civil society in decision making
- Complex trainings and capacity building activities empowered people and equipped with project approach in problem solving at local level
- Regular training and workshops on creating project application involving different stakeholders and community actors formed skilled local selfgovernments and Civil society members
- The annual regional Call for applications developed by locally formed partnerships (the Regional budget involved)
- The local Call for applications developed by locally formed partnerships (local budget involved)


