Step 1: Project's emergence

Identification of a cooperation idea

- Link with the LEADER strategy
- Where is the need for a partner?
- Identify and hierarchize cooperation ideas
- Stakeholder commitment and involvement
- Time for an additional project

Identification of potential partners

- Are there already existing connections?
- How many partners are realistic?
- Writing and dissemination of a cooperation offer (not too vague/not too detailed)
- Selection of partners



Step 2: Project's development: from the idea to the project

First meeting with potential partners

- **A crucial step – Should be well prepared**
- **Objectives**
 - to discover respective contexts according to the topic of the cooperation
 - to agree on common objectives, common actions and budget
 - to distribute tasks and responsibilities among the partnership
 - to identify and mobilise financial and human resources
- **To validate locally the cooperation project among local stakeholders**

Formalisation of the cooperation project

- **Writing the application by each partner/LAG /Selection by each partner**

Step 3: Project's implementation

Management of the partnership

- Organisation of regular meetings (on-site/on-line): technical issues, study visits, peer reviews...



Sharing cooperation results

- Regular report about the cooperation project among LAG's stakeholders - monitoring
- Communication action to disseminate cooperation results

Step 4: Finalisation

Evaluation of the project

- using monitoring data
- organising a small workshop

Reflection in the team/LAG and with partners

- organising a meeting
